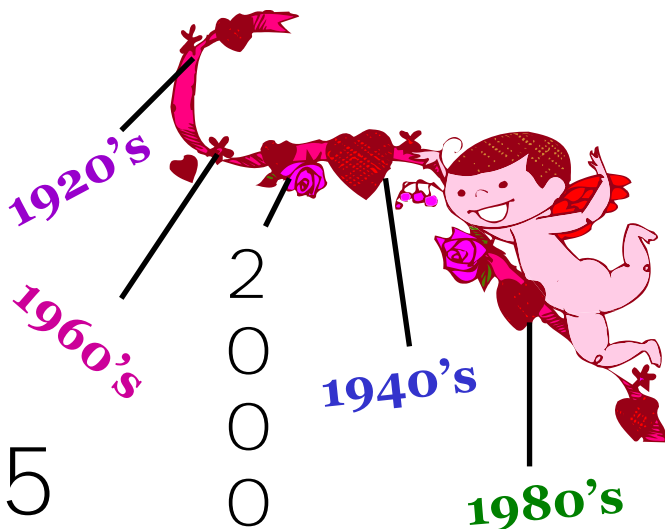

From Your Pastor...

The Precious Love of God – Isaiah 38:1-20

Because of the love of God, Hezekiah found healing when he was destined to die of some kind of fatal disease. Maybe you remember the story of King Hezekiah. Found in the beginning of this chapter, we see he was told by the prophet Isaiah that God said that King Hezekiah was going to die and he needed to get his house in order. When Hezekiah heard the pronouncement he turned his head to the wall and prayed: ***“Remember, O Lord, how I have walked before You faithfully and with wholehearted devotion and have done what is good in your eyes.”*** And then he wept over his impending death. God heard his prayer and saw his tears and granted his request to live, giving him fifteen more years.

Here is my point, Hezekiah’s life was given back to him by the love of his gracious God who chose to answer a prayer from one of His servants. Many of you have struggled with death and disease and some of you are still in the middle of that struggle. God hears the prayers of His children and by His sovereignty He chooses to heal some but for others he has a different plan...eternal life with Him in heaven right away.

Never give up on the Lord; He may have a plan that will give you life for a little more time. Just remember, if you read on in the life of Hezekiah, he made some decisions that were not the best for his relationship with God. If God does extend your life that is on the brink of death, *it is to have your life count for God in a new and fresh way that others can benefit by the “Love of God” in your life.* You may say, “This doesn’t relate to me, I am not in that situation.” Dear friends there is no guarantee that any of us might not in a moment’s notice find our life in danger from cancer or some other disease that is fatal. Listen, *we all will die some day*; some of us just go a little quicker than others.

After you have read *Isaiah 38:1-20* focus on verse *15-17.*

15 But what can I say? He has spoken to me, and he himself has done this. I will walk humbly all my years because of this anguish of my soul.

16 Lord, by such things men live; and my spirit finds life in them too. You restored me to health and let me live.

17 Surely it was for my benefit that I suffered such anguish. In your love you kept me from the pit of destruction; you have put all my sins behind your back.
