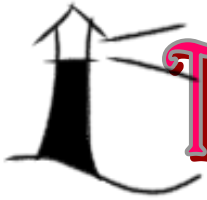

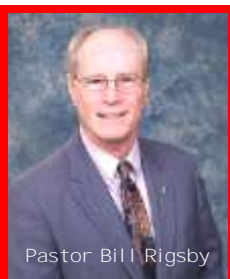
Envelopes will be available at the reservation table in the Welcome Center. Fill out the envelope and place your money inside for your reservation (s).
