“Being Faithful and Obedient”

Jeremiah was called of God even before he was born. (Jeremiah 1:5) His ministry was to the people of God and yet he was not guaranteed that his ministry would be successful. In fact, the people Jeremiah preached to regularly opposed him at every turn and did not believe what he had to say. What kept Jeremiah going and preaching and prophesying about his beloved people and nation?

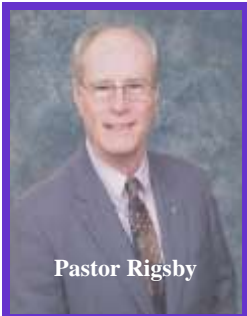
He was called of God! And, **he knew God was with him.** (Jeremiah 1:5) God placed him where He wanted him to be and Jeremiah obeyed the Lord. Being obedient does not necessarily mean that someone will be successful in what they do. Their goals may not come to a reality; people may not respond to the message that they have. People around them might call them a failure but God calls them faithful.

We are all called to be a part of the family of God. We are all called to love God and our neighbor. As Christians, we are called to love our brothers in faith. 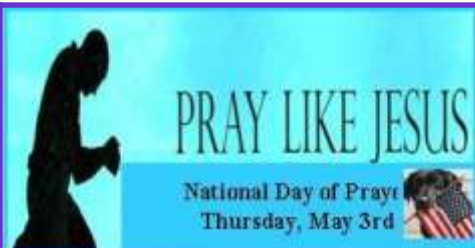
