

"Being Faithful and Obedient"

Jeremiah was called of God even before he was born. (Jeremiah 1:5) His ministry was to the people of God and yet he was not guaranteed that his ministry would be successful. In fact, the people Jeremiah preached to regularly opposed him at ever turn and did not believe what he had to say. What kept Jeremiah going and preaching and prophe-

sying about his beloved people and nation? <u>He was called of God!</u> And, <u>he knew God was with him.</u> (Jeremiah 1:5) God placed him where He wanted him to be and Jeremiah obeyed the Lord. 
