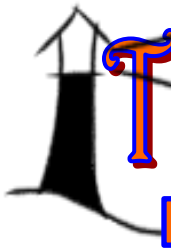

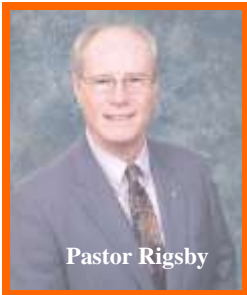

The Baptist Faith and Message says under the section called **Stewardship** the following: "According to the Scriptures,

Christians should contribute of their means cheerfully, regularly, systematically, proportionately, and liberally for the advancement of the Redeemer's cause on earth."

It also tells us that we really hold in trust all that God has given to us so that it can be used to His glory. This is a binding relationship we have to the Lord who has saved us and provided all we have not just for our comfort but really for His purposes here on earth. What we have, we owe to Him. I can't believe that it is November. I also can't believe I am in my tenth year here at North Anderson Baptist Church. Over these years I am sorry to say that I have not covered the study of a tithe with the children. As a young child I remember my mom giving me a dime to place in the offering plate. She did this to get me involved in the service. I was responsible for holding on to the money through Sunday School and then during the service I would place my dime in the offertory plate. This was her way of teaching me about our tithe to God. I have to say that it worked. As a 13 year old, my first paid job was delivering the paper after school. Then when I moved to bagging grocery at 15. I remember what it was like to give more than a dime, to actually give my tenth of what I earned to God. I have never had a problem with giving a tithe. I have failed God in teaching about giving a tithe and that I am sorry about.

For the last few weeks of October and into the season of Thanksgiving in November I will be teaching during children's church about a tithe. What is it? Why do we tithe? And where does the Bible talk about our tithe. I believe that we should always tithe and always be thankful for what God has giving us.
