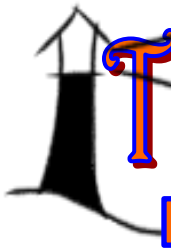

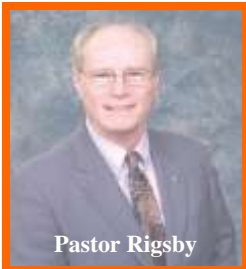

- 1 Adult toothbrush (factory sealed, no multipacks)
- 1 4 oz.- 6 oz Toothpaste (no travel size)
- 1 3.2 oz. - 6 oz. bar of soap (no travel size, factory wrapped)
- 2 rolls of hard candy (Life Savers/Breath Savers/Mentos)
