From Your Pastor ...

Dear Family of God,

Every family needs to look at their income and then what they spend. Everyone in the family contributes something to the family. In the church family, each of us are called by God to **contribute financially** to the welfare of and the ministry of the body. It involves a lot of things; it might be utility bills, mortgage or money to give to the mission enterprises that we do or that in which our Association, State or the Southern Baptist Convention participates.



As a body of Christ, we choose to be ruled by the Scriptures, God's Holy Word! His Word tells us to bring the tithes into the storehouse. (**Malachi 3:10, *Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this,* says the LORD Almighty, "and see if I will not throw open the flood-gates of heaven and pour out so much blessing that there will not be room enough to store it.) Paul basically says, on Sunday, first day of the week, set aside a portion of your income, so that you can have it ready to give. (**1 Corinthians 16:2, *On the first day of every week, each one of you should set aside a sum of money in keeping with your income, saving it up, so that when I come no collections will have to be made.***)**

Then, in the second letter to the Corinthians, Paul says to the church, "...**see that you also excel in this grace of giving.**" (**2 Corinthians 8:7**) Paul is not through yet about the church's (*the people of God*) giving. He says, "**Remember this: Whoever sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also reap generously. ⁷ Each of you should give what you have decided in your heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. ⁸ And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work.**"

So, let me ask you, "*How are you giving to the church of Jesus Christ here at North Anderson Baptist?*" On **Wednesday, August 21 at 6:30 pm**, we will have a business meeting regarding the financial status of our church family. Please come and see what has happened in a little over half of this year and be a part of the decision-making process of **YOUR** church.

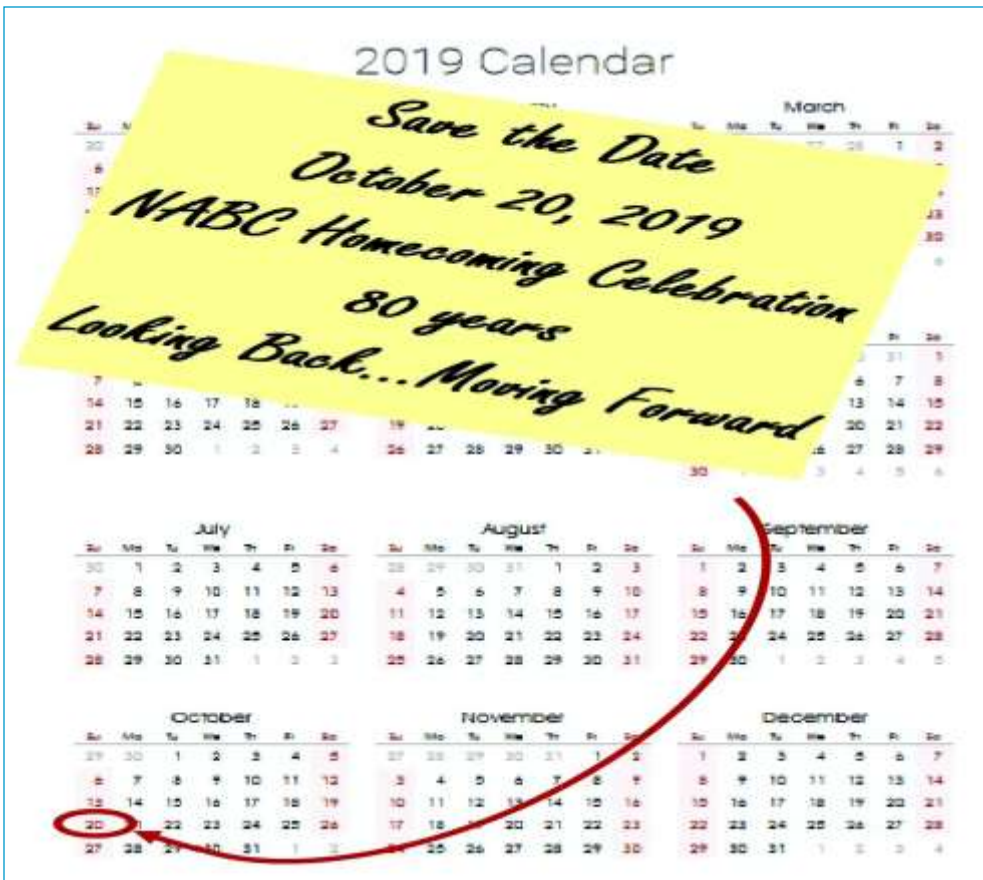
