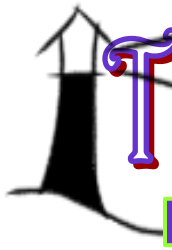

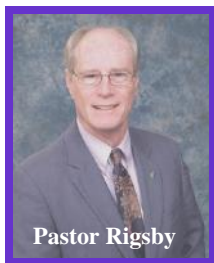

From Your Pastor...

It's Time To Say "I Will" to Corporate Worship

Thom Rainey shares 4 thoughts that we must consider when attending corporate worship.

1. I will attend worship service

It's simple, people will miss worship for just about anything - sports, vacations, entertainment etc... What would happen if all members of the congregation put a firm priority on our corporate weekly worship?

2. I will pray before I attend worship service.

Whether you pray the night before or the morning of, you will pray. Pray for what? First, my own attitude of worship. Second, that God will speak to me in worship. Third, I will pray for others in the worship service. Fourth, I will pray for my family that we will not get frustrated or have conflicts before we attend. Fifth, I will pray for the music to glorify God and the preaching to magnify Jesus.

3. I will pray as I enter the worship center or sanctuary.

Once again, I will pray for my heart and attitude. I will pray for fellow believers who are there and worshipping God with me. I will pray for the unbelievers that they will hear clearly the Gospel of Jesus and respond with repentance and faith in Jesus. I will pray the power of the Holy Spirit to be so strong that He convicts all who are there and listening to the Word of God. I will pray that God will remove all distractions and help all who are there to focus on worshipping God.

4. I will pray that I will be a worshipper instead of a judge.

I want to have the attitude of worship than judging some sporting event. I will choose not to judge those around me and neither will I impose my standard or judgment upon the music and the preaching of the Word.

Take time to read Acts 2:41-47. Why was the level of commitment so high among the believers in the early church? And then read John 4:21-24. What did Jesus mean by worshipping God, "*in spirit and in truth?*"
